- 4 Quality of writing** (10 points)
Does the PSA reflect proper spelling and grammar?

One Grand Prize of \$2,000 will be awarded. In addition, an NRSF video producer will come to the Grand Prize winner's school to work with the winner to professionally film the winning concept. One runner-up will receive \$1,000. A second runner up will receive \$500. If the entry form of the Grand Prize winner and the Runner-Up are co-signed by a teacher, those teachers will receive a \$100 honorarium.
